Middlewick Holiday Cottages Responsible Visitor Charter 2011

When you stay at Middlewick we would ask you to try to help us both ethically and environmental by considering the following:

- Feel free to pick herbs for your cooking from the small herb garden adjacent to our site office.
- Trying locally sourced food and produce. Somerset has a wonderful variety to offer.
- Choose if possible to give the car a holiday some days while at Middlewick by walking or cycling (the latter can be organized locally if you do not bring your own bikes). There are amazing places to visit and sites to see very close to us. We are only a 20-25 minute walk over the Tor in to Glastonbury itself.
- Please use energy carefully by turning off lighting when not in use and not having the heating on all day. If you use our stream room and pool please ensure everything is turned off when you leave the building.
- Switch off lights and TVs when not in use. Please pay special attention to the lights outside your cottage as well (particularly during the day). We have safety/ security lights that are operated by movement sensors on site, but otherwise at night we try to keep the place as dark as possible. It reminds us of how life once was and adds to the beauty of the countryside.
- Please close doors and windows when you using the heating.
- Please avoid excessive use of water.
- We are not on mains sewage system and instead have to rely on our own septic system. Please be careful not to flush items such as sanitary pads, tissues, tooth floss, hand/ baby/ makeup/ face wipes or condoms, even if the packaging says they are biodegradable. They can block our system and reduce its efficiency.
- Please use the bins provided for recycling. We have separate bins for glass and dry mixed recyclables (cardboard, paper, tins, plastic drinks cartons, milk/ juice cartons) on site. Other items need to go into our third (non recyclable) bin of disposed of at a local council waste disposal facility. If you are unsure please ask us or one of our staff members.
